SUBJECT: "Uncapped" Income Limits for 2025

The Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act of 1998 (Title V of Public Law 105-276) enacted a provision that directed the Department to grant exceptions to at least ten jurisdictions that are currently "capped" under HUD's low-and moderate-income limits. Currently under this exception, a total of 80 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement grantees and 44 HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) participating jurisdictions, including ten additional HOME consortia members, may use "uncapped" income limits that reflect 80 percent of the actual median income for the area. These grantees are listed in the attachments.

In addition, the attachments to this memorandum provide the 2025 "uncapped" income limits for the jurisdictions covered by this exception. For your information, the "uncapped" income limits for 2000 – 2024 are also included in the attachments. These calculations are described in HUD's FY 2025 Income Limits Briefing Material, which may be obtained at: https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/home-datasets/files/2025-Uncapped-IncomeLmts-Memo.pdf. Please ensure that grantees that choose to use the "uncapped" income limits for some or all their HOME or CDBG-assisted activities reflect this determination in their consolidated plans and annual action plans.

The use of the term "low-income limits" in the attachment is a reference to the Section 8 low-income limits (i.e., 80 percent of the median income for the area). These are the income limits established by HUD and referred to in the definition of "low-and moderate-income person" in the CDBG regulations at 24 CFR 570.3, and in the definition of "low-income families" in the HOME regulations at 24 CFR 92.2.

The effective date for these limits is June 1, 2025.
