(Buildings Nos. 111 through 121. Refer to Bulletin No. 6, "Equipment Specifications for Child Service Facilities" for Furniture and Equipment for Child Service Wings in Building Nos. 112 and 114)

TENANT ACTIVITIES SPACE

General

The furniture and equipment required for Tenant Activities Space on Family Dwelling Projects are fully specified in Bulletin No. 18, "Furniture and Equipment Specifications for Tenant (Morale) Activities Buildings and Cafeterias for Dormitory Projects." It is intended that all the requirements and designations set forth in those specifications shall apply to and be followed in the manufacture and furnishing of the items herein set forth. Quantities required of specific items are listed in a table at the end of this section.

Outdoor Equipment

Specifications for playfield apparatus, playground, athletic and other equipment items for outdoor tenant activities will be issued as a separate bulletin.

Stage Curtains and Equipment

Tenant Activity Building No. 121 shall be provided with complete stage equipment equal to that set forth for Building No. 1000 in Bulletin No. 18 mentioned above, and as illustrated in drawings of Bulletin No. 22, "Interior Furnishings for Project Services Facilities". Stage curtain shall be Wissahickon #666 welour or equal and shall be flame proofed. The wiring and fixtures needed for the stage lighting will be furnished and installed by other contractors.

The furnishing and installation of curtains and curtain hardware shall follow and be like those specified for similar items in Bulletin No. 18 mentioned above.

Window and Blackout Curtains

For general construction and operating details see Plate 30 and 31 of Bulletin No. 22 as above mentioned.

If standard metal operating hardware is obtainable the same shall be used in preference to wood tracks etc. shown on plate 30. Contractor shall advise the Authority before signing contract if metal hardware is obtainable.

Window Curtains

For all units curtains shall be made or installed for use in the following rooms of materials as called for.

- Lobby - Hexter 27260 or equal
- Lounge - Hexter 26676 or equal
- Club Room - Hexter 27259 or equal

Blackout Curtains

For all windows in Tenant Activity Rooms furnish and install Blackout Curtains of #AA Hexter Black Sateen or equal thereto.

Paint Treatment

For color treatment, of painted walls etc., refer to pages 20 and 21 of "Interior Furnishings for Project Services Facilities".

Motion Picture and Sound Equipment

For use in Units No. 115 to 121 inclusive, (as required only), supply the following to be purchased according to General Schedule of Supplies, Procurement Division, U. S. Treasury Department.

One Dual 16mm. motion picture sound projector unit with changeover box, complete with all necessary connection cables, current supply cables, projection lamps, tubes and extra exciter lamps, 1600' take-up reel, two sets of spare belts, aperture cleaning brushes, spare fuses, and supply of oil cans: in accordance with Procurement Division Specifications #429-B.

SPECIFICATION FOR CLINIC EQUIPMENT IN TDU COMMUNITY BUILDINGS

Intent - It is the intention of this specification that the contractor shall furnish, deliver and install the following equipment to be used in Clinics in Community Buildings of the TDU Series. The materials furnished shall be the best of their several kinds. Substitution equal to those articles specifically indicated may be made by the equipment contractor only upon obtaining written consent from the proper authority to do so. For equipment requirements and quantities in the various size units see table following this specification.

Bulletin Board - 2'-0 x 2'-0 of 3 ply plywood

Chair - Type XC as specified and shown for Dormitory Projects.

Counter and Baby Dressing Bins - shall be built in accordance with standard approved kitchen cabinet construction of solid pine or white wood enamelled 2 coats. See drawing indicating design and dimensions.

Counter and Wall Cabinet - shall be built in accordance with standard approved kitchen cabinet construction of solid pine or white wood enamelled 2 coats, and shall be complete with all necessary hardware. See drawings showing dimensions, door and drawer arrangements for various size units.

Curtain and Rod - Curtain to be of 8 ounce duck hemmed top and double hemmed at bottom, with grommets for pins. Provide proper pins for attaching to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter hardwood rod furnished by this contractor.

Demonstration Table - constructed of hardwood with white enamel finish 2 coats. Top size 24" x 48".

Desk - Single Pedestal wood desk, top size 20" x 34", natural finish.

Examining Table - shall be of hard wood, natural finish with three section top, head and leg rest adjustable. Table shall have side arm extensions, and adjustable heel stirrups. Length when extended shall be 68" without extension 38". Aloe 75 P6782 or equal.

Two piece Cushion - for examining table shall be Aloe 75 P6783 or equal.

File Cabinet - Hardwood to consist of 3 drawers for filing of letters, and one drawer for filing of cards, together with appropriate top and base.

Floor Lamp - with adjustable height and with gooseneck; white enamel finish. Aloe 75 P6413 or equal.

Foot Stool - of solid hard wood 15" x 15" x 8" high.

Hooks and Strips - to be made of 1" x 2-1/2" leveled strips of solid hardwood with 3/4" dowels 2-1/2" exposed 6" apart placed at an angle to act as hooks.

Instrument Sterilizer - 16" x 6" x 4" to have full automatic control. Aloe 75 PC416 or equal.

Instrument Table - acid proof. Top size 16" x 20", height 32"; of porcelain enamel steel construction mounted on casters. Aloe 75 P6321 or equal.

Mirror - of good quality, 14" x 24" with simple solid hardwood frame. All to be firmly attached to wall with necessary hardware and screws.

Sanitary Waste receptacle - to have 12 quart capacity. 14-1/2" high 11" diameter. White enamel finish. Aloe 75 P6714 or equal.

Scale, Adult Doctors Type Platform - white enamel finish. Aloe 75 P9185 or equal.

Scale, Infants - Capacity of 18 pounds. Aloe 75 P5288 or equal.

Soap Dispenser - for use with liquid soap. Aloe 75 S3661 or equal.

Stool - wood, 18" high.


Utility Table - top size 24" x 36" similar in construction and finish to Demonstration table.

Waste Paper Receptacle - of fibre, size 14" x 12" x 16" according to Federal Standards Specification AA-D-201.




ITEM Nos. 2 & 3 OF UNITS Nos 111, 113, 115, 116, & 117


ITEM Nos. 2 & 3 OF UNITS Nos 118, 119, 120, & 121
